- Poland has pursued a policy of economic liberalization since 1990 and today stands out as a success story among transition economies. In 2008, GDP grew an estimated 4.8%, based on rising private consumption, a jump in corporate investment, and European Union funds inflows. Since 2004, EU membership and access to EU structural funds have provided a major boost to the economy..
