






ERA - STRUCTURE

- ERA, the European Rental Association, is the representative association of the equipment rental sector in Europe.
- ERA represents over 4,700 rental companies in Europe, either directly or through 13 national rental associations.
- Potential to grow up to ~ 20 associations in the future

Market Trends and Drivers

- → Superior service
- Most rental companies plan on investing in better and newer services in order to differentiate themselves from competition
- Flexibility, availability, proximity, on-time deliveries
- → Need for more environmental equipment
- Following new engines regulations, compliant machines will be more expensive and require specialist maintenance
- End-users are expected to prefer to rent such machines than purchase them.
