



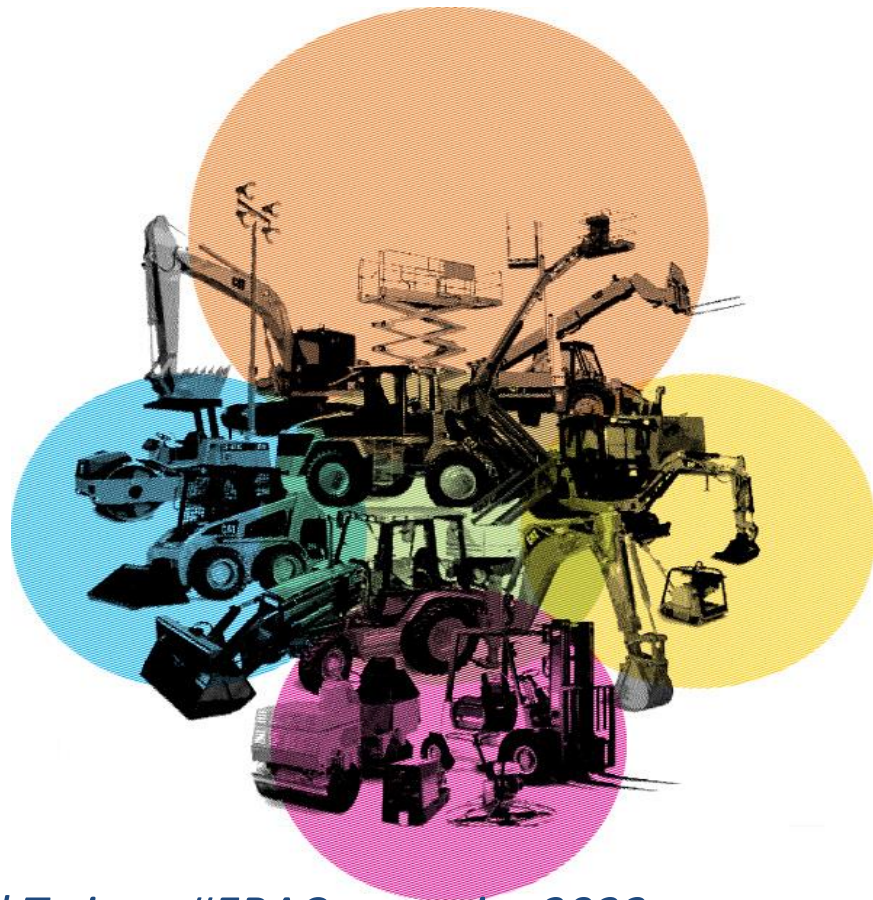

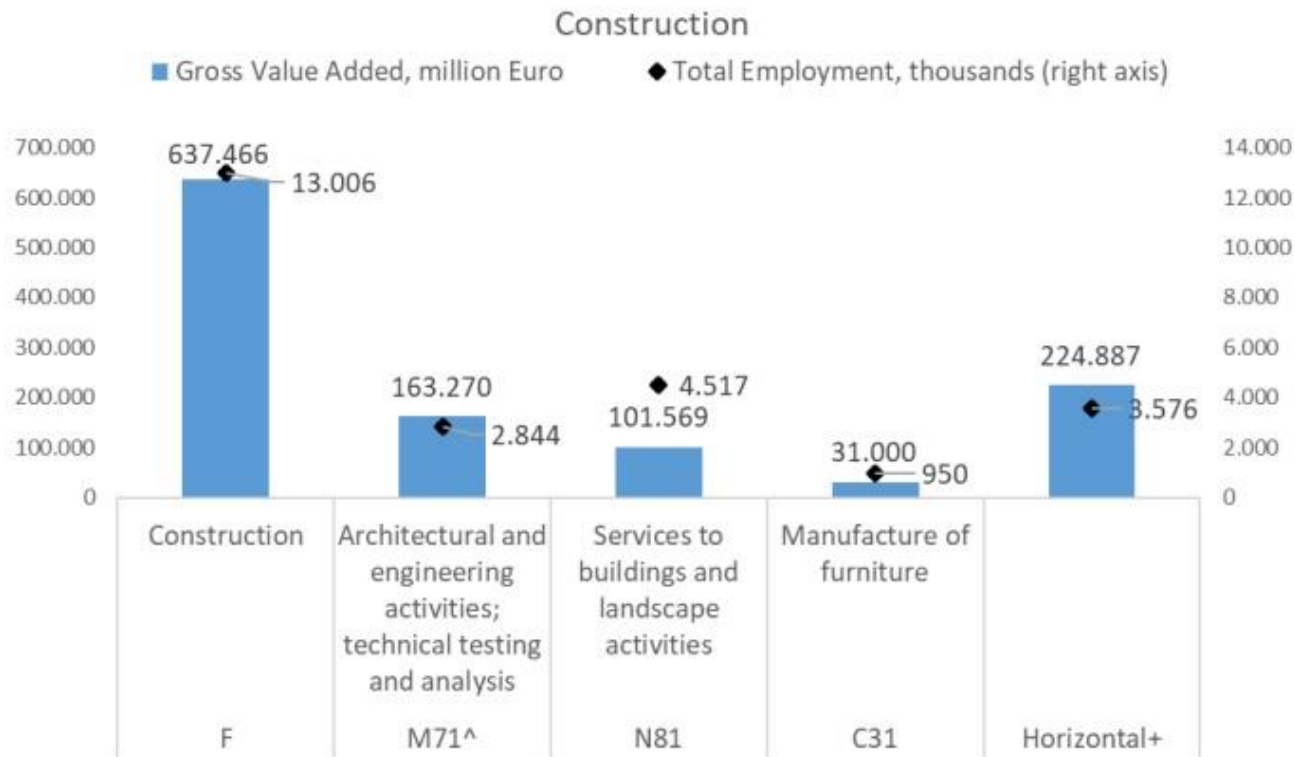

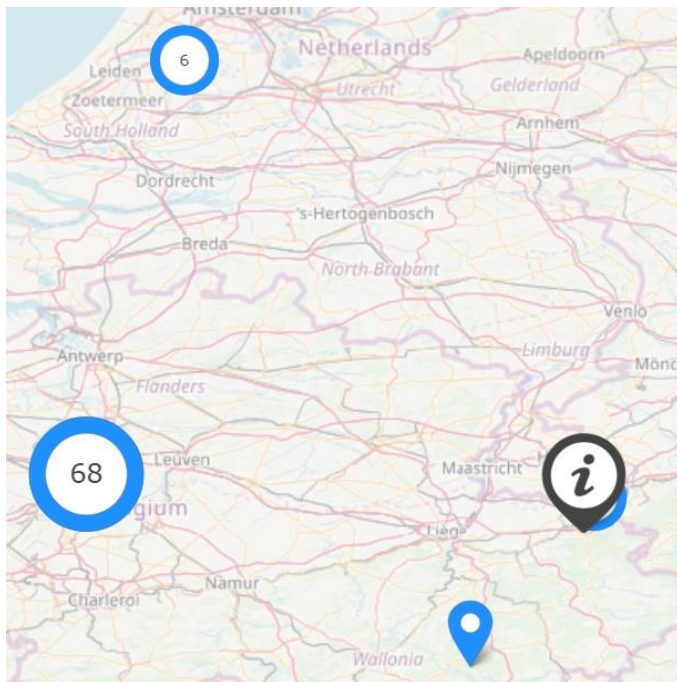
European Year of Skills 2023 – 9 May 2023
